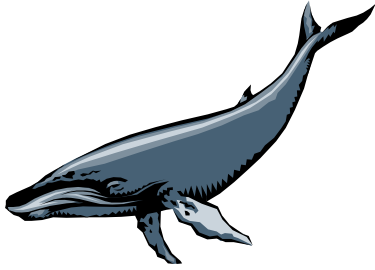


MAUI ATTRACTIONS

1. **Whaler's Village Museum & Shopping Center**- Located next to the



Westin Maui, the Whaler's Village has local stores, designer boutiques, fashion, art and restaurants. The free museum is open from 10am – 6pm and the shops and restaurants are open daily 9:30am to 10pm. For more information, including a store directory, visit www.whalersvillage.com.

2. **Maui Ocean Center**- Explore the native creatures of Hawaii's deep ocean without getting wet at the Maui Ocean Center. See hammerhead sharks, visit the living reef, get up close and personal with starfish and urchins at the tide pool and much more! Open daily from 9am – 5pm, admission is \$25 for adults and \$18 for children ages 3-12.



Located at 192 Ma'alaea Rd in Wailuku, Maui. From the Westin Maui, turn right onto HI-30/Honoapiilani Hwy and travel for approximately 17.5 mi (about 30 minutes). The Maui Ocean Center is five minutes past the tunnel, on the ocean side. Take a right at the stop light in Ma'alaea and enter the aquarium parking lot. 3. **Lahaina**- Home to shopping and historical landmarks alike, Lahaina is a



hub for activity. You can walk the streets while window-shopping, have a bite to eat at one of many restaurants, brush up on your history at the courthouse and see the largest banyan tree in the United States. For more information visit

Lahaina. Shuttles run every hour from 10:15am – 10:15pm.

4. **Haleakala National Park**- Haleakala National Park extends from the 10,023 foot (3055m) summit of Haleakala down the southeast flank of the mountain to the Kipahulu coast near Hana. These two sections of the park are not directly connected by road, but both can be reached from Kahului.

There is no public transportation available either to or in the park. **To the Summit Area:** Park headquarters and the 10,023 foot (3055m) summit can be reached from Kahului via Route 37 to 377 to 378. Driving time to the summit from Kahului is approximately 1.5 hours. **To the coastal area (Kipahulu):** Kipahulu is reached via Route 36 to 360 to 31. Driving time from Kahului is approximately 3 hours. The park is open 24 hours a day. Park Headquarters Visitor Center (7000 ft/2134 m) - 6:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Haleakala Visitor Center (9740 ft/2969 m) - 5:15 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Kipahulu Visitor Center (sea level) - 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. *All park visitors are required to purchase a recreational use pass upon entering Haleakala National Park. Daily passes are non-transferrable and are valid for 3 days including the date of purchase.* **Private Vehicle:** \$10. Admits private, non-commercial vehicle (14 pax capacity or less) and all occupants to Haleakala National Park including both the Summit and Kipahulu Areas. **Per Person:** \$5. Admits one individual with no car to Haleakala National Park including both the Summit and Kipahulu Areas- typically used for bicyclists, hikers and pedestrians. Youth 15 and under are admitted free. 5. **Maui Gold® Pineapple Tours-** Take a tour of a real, working pineapple plantation led by Maui Pineapple Company workers whose colorful



commentary weaves history, facts and trivia into an authentic pineapple plantation experience. Ride in the luxurious Maui Gold® shuttle van to fields being planted and/or harvested. Learn first-hand about the unique growing cycle, planting and harvesting techniques of pineapple, the symbol of hospitality. In the field, walk through rows of fresh pineapple, tasting samples and selecting a perfect specimen of sweet Maui Gold® to take home as a souvenir. Four different tours to choose from, all tours meet at Kapalua

6. **Other Tours & Activities-** American Express operates two (2) Tour and Activities Desks in the hotel, one in the lobby and the other beachside by the pool.
