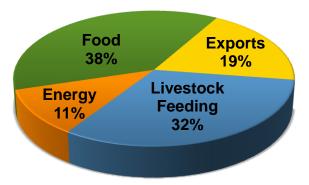
#### \$3.3 Billion Revenue in 2012



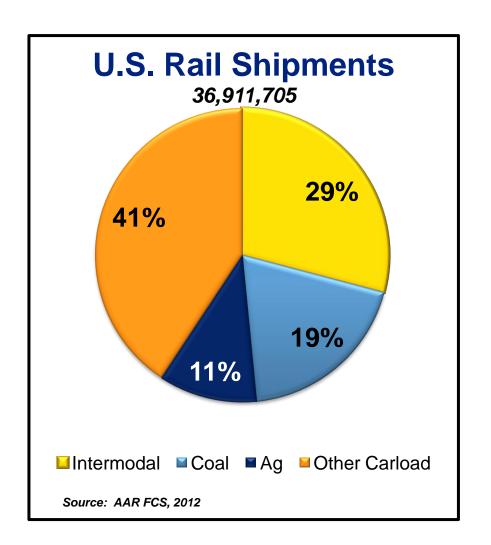
#### **Revenue Mix**

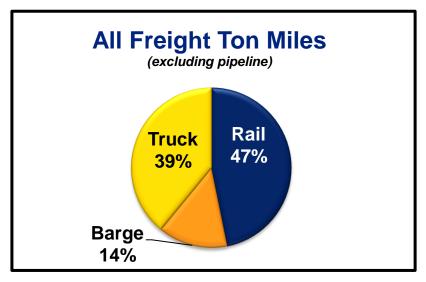


# Key End-Use Markets (% of Revenue)

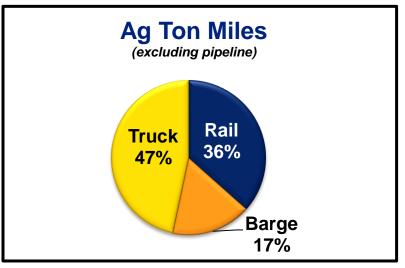


#### **Rail Impact on Transportation**





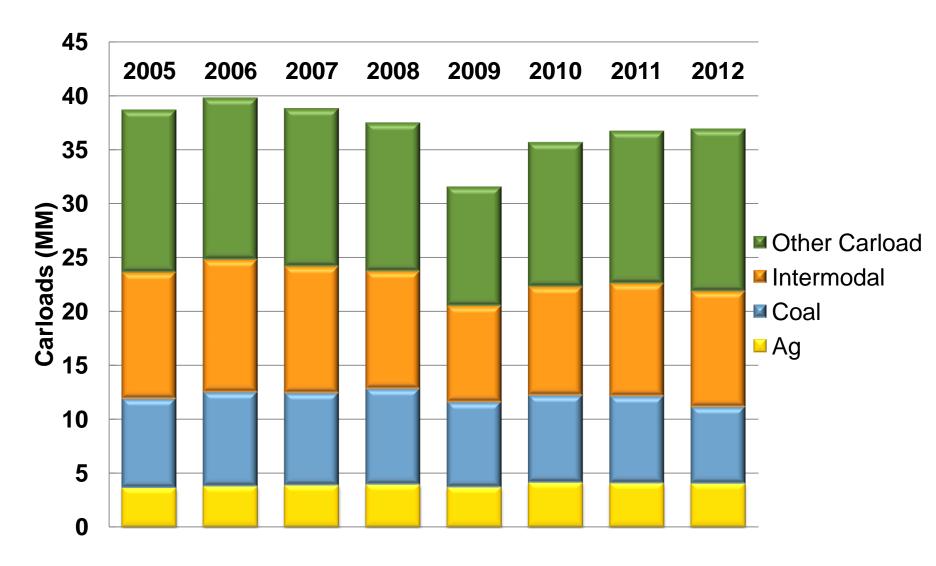

### **Annual U.S. Rail and Ag Shipment Comparison**



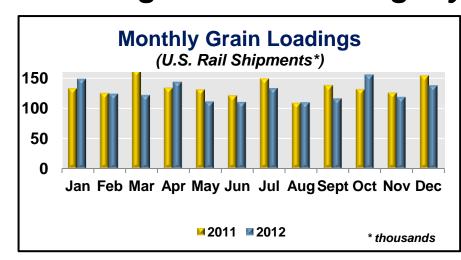

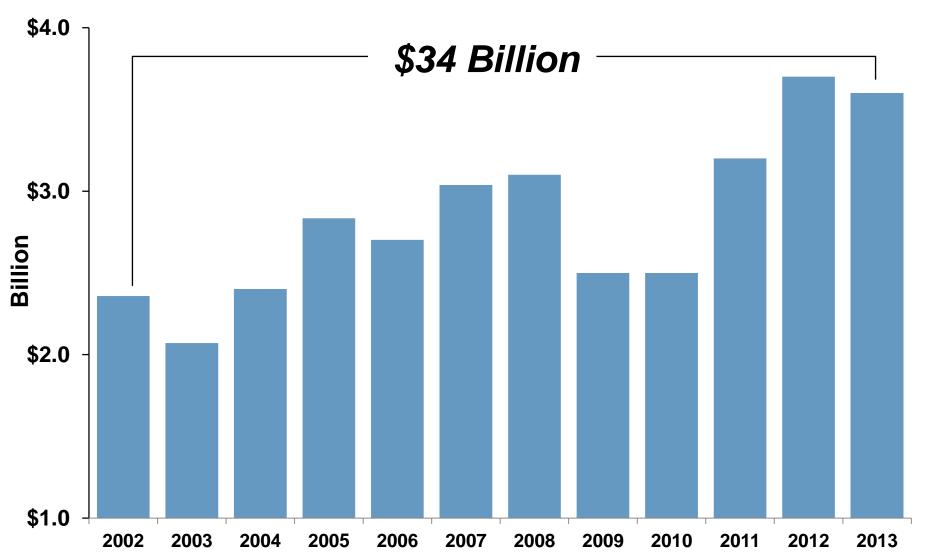

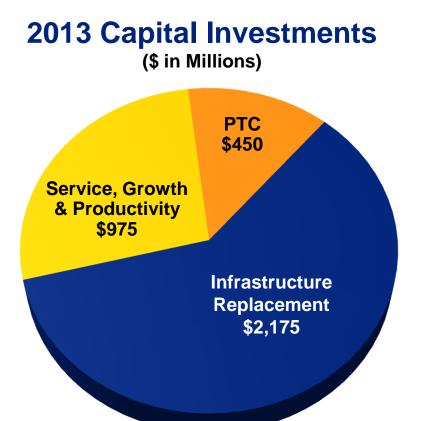

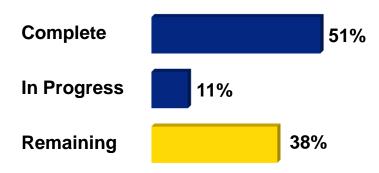
