

Weekly volumes reflect continued slow recovery: The 2010 peak was 682K in early September, 60% of the way back










BNSF Capital Commitments



U.S Exports to Asia



2030 Growth Projections

- Population to grow to 364 million
- VMT to grow by 150 percent
- Freight rail to increase by 92 percent
