WRDA 2024

Water Resources Development Act (WRDA)

- PRIORITY: Adhere to Congressional intent for the seven construction and major rehabilitation projects funded in the Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act (IIJA) and to remain 100% federal funded to completion.
- TIMING: WRDA 2024 may be considered by the House and Senate in Spring 2024, with hopes to enact a final law by September 2024.

Snake River Dams

The Columbia-Snake River System is the third-largest grain export corridor in the world, transporting nearly 30 percent of U.S. grain and oilseed exports.

A multiyear mediation came to an end in December 2023 with the announcement of an MOU that calls for studies to mitigate the effects of removing the dams.
