David is a magna cum laude graduate in feed science from Kansas State University's Department of Grain Science.

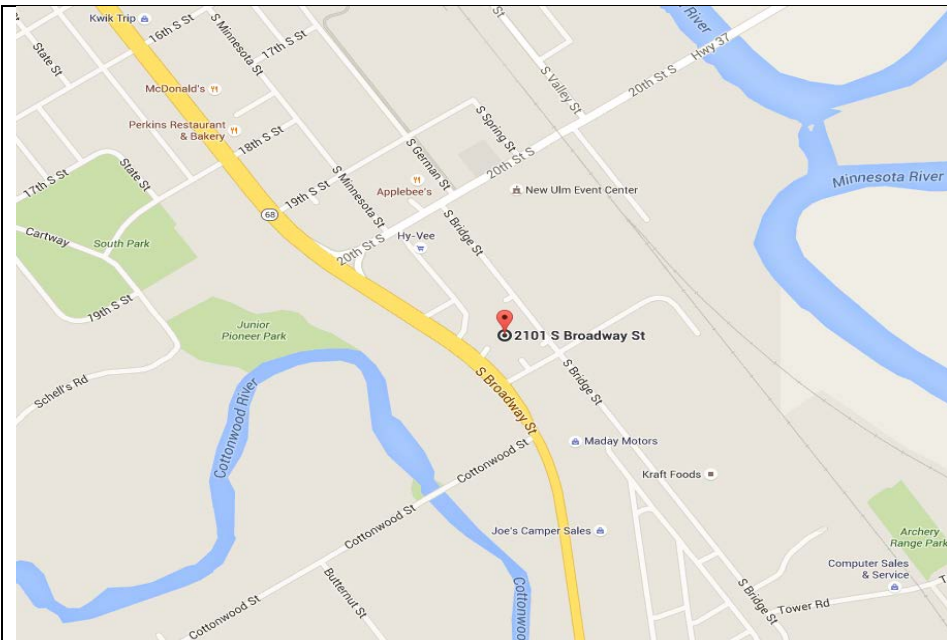
### **Matt Frederking**

Matt Frederking is the Vice President of Regulatory Affairs at Ralco based in Marshall, MN. Frederking is an International HACCP Alliance Lead Instructor and was instrumental in developing the HACCP training course taught at Kansas State University (KSU).

He continues to teach HACCP courses at least once a semester at KSU for grain elevators, feed mills, ethanol plants, feed ingredient suppliers and other allied industry members. He serves as an adjunct faculty member at Kansas State University.

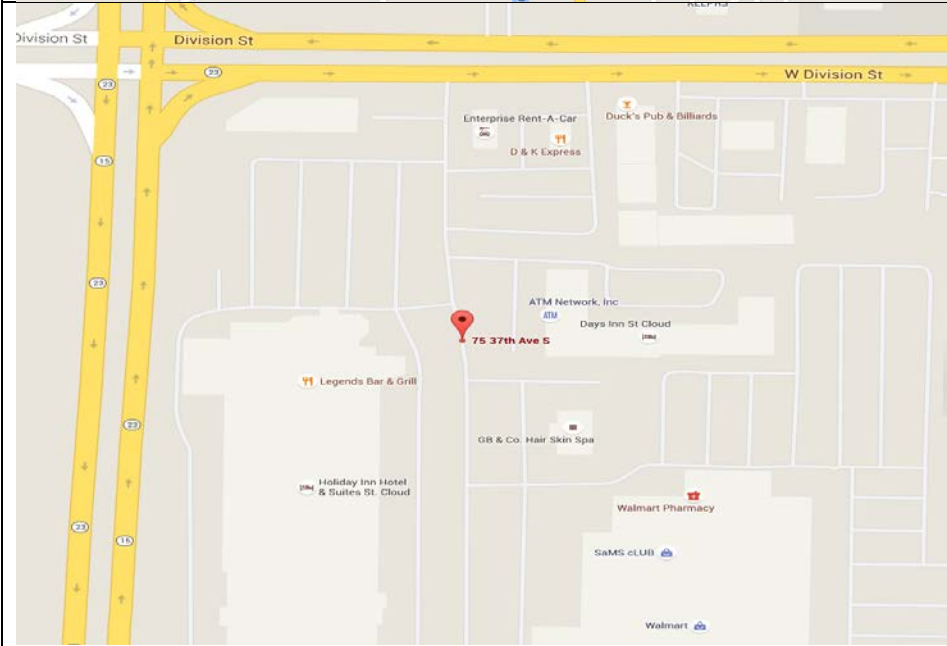

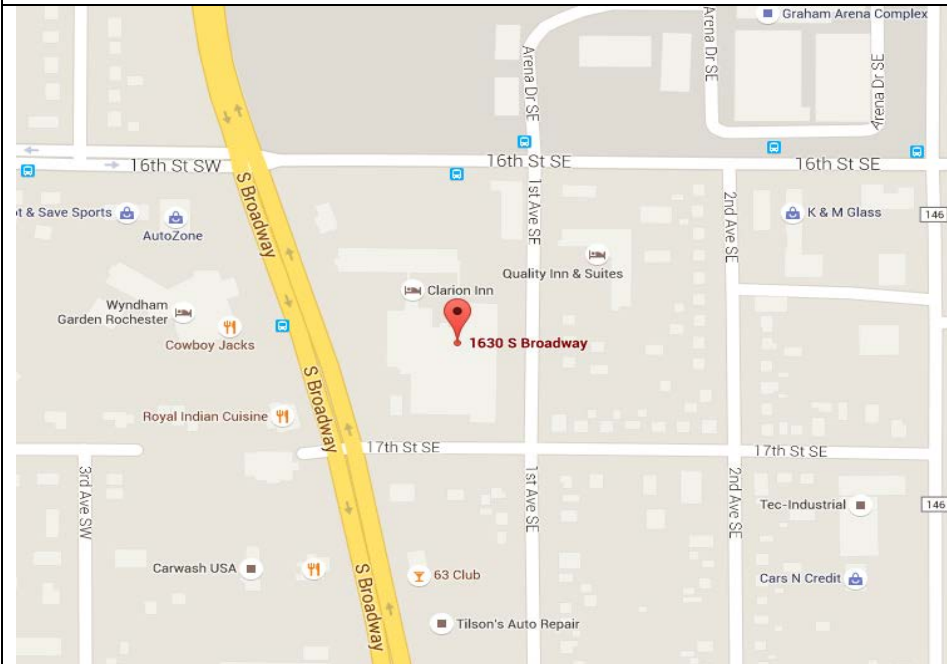
