NATIONAL GRAIN AND FEED FOUNDATION GOLF TOURNAMENT SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES Steele Canyon Golf Club | San Diego, CA March 14, 2016

The annual golf tournament supports the National Grain and Feed Foundation. Established in 1965, the National Grain and Feed Foundation supports public education and research projects that benefit the grain, feed, and processing industry, and enhance the industry's presence to the public while positioning it for future growth. The Foundation is funded entirely by voluntary

corporate and individual contributions. As a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, contributions to the Foundation are tax deductible.

The 27-hole championship Steele Canyon Golf Club was personally designed by Gary Player, each of the three nines offers a distinct environment and type of play for all levels of golfers. The rugged Canyon Course's dramatic shot making challenges and breathtaking elevations are balanced by the Ranch Course's winding fairways through the fields of a working ranch, and the Meadow course's beautiful woodlands and streams stretching along the valley floor. Steele Canyon has been awarded Golf Digest's Four Star Rating, one of only three golf clubs so honored in San Diego County.
